Last Spring, the St. Peter School Board and our Principal, Mrs. Mors, saw the opportunity to make another improvement to our school facility for the benefit of our children. One they would *truly* appreciate. Some better playground equipment! On short notice, \$6,500.00 was raised in one fell swoop at St. Peter School Auctioneers Nite, with the simple waiving of some numbered paddles. An announcement for the formation of a "Playground Improvement Committee" was made, and soon we had several parents involved, providing their input, and making decisions.

After some diligent research, the Playground Improvement Committee decided to obtain proposals from the same company that installed the existing playground equipment on the north-west corner of the parish property (www.GETREIL.com). After several meetings, the Committee decided on an eight seat swing set, a glider, three tetherball stations, a basketball hoop and all new balls, jump-ropes, etc...We also needed to excavate and enlarge the play area where much of this was to be installed. To accomplish all of this, the cost rose to just over \$11,00.00. In short order, due to the generosity of our school children parents, another \$4,500.0 was raised during the first few weeks of school.

With the enthusiastic support and approval of the project by our Pastor, Fr. Anglim, and our Parish Business Manager, Deacon Paul Neurauter, the committee placed the order and went about the task of recruiting parent volunteers to help install the equipment. Not surprisingly, the response was overwhelming, and we had more than enough people to help with the assembly and installation.

On Saturday, October 4, 2008, a "Community Build Out" was held. We had beautiful weather, a delicious donated lunch and well over 25 motivated workers who completed installation of our new equipment in less than one day.

Reports forwarded from recess are extremely positive! Our school children have thoroughly enjoyed playing with all of the new equipment. Once again, St. Peter School parents delivered for the benefit of all of our children. The Playground Improvement Committee offers our sincere thanks to all those who supported and assisted in this worthwhile improvement project!
